CLUBHOUSE DRESS CODE

CLUBHOUSE DRESS CODE ~ Proper dress will be determined by the occasion or event and will be included in the announcement of events. If not specified it is country club casual or golf attire. No hats or visors to be worn backwards at any time. No swimming attire allowed inside the clubhouse.

MEN and BOY'S ACCEPTABLE DRESS

Shirts with collars and sleeves, slacks, jogging outfits (nylon or silk), golf shorts, walking shorts, mock turtlenecks, and dress jeans void of any holes (Clubhouse Only).

• MEN and BOY'S UNACCEPTABLE DRESS

Tank tops, graphic t-shirts, fishnet tops, cut-offs, jeans with holes, and bathing suits are not permitted. Hats or visors worn backwards.

WOMEN and GIRL'S ACCEPTABLE DRESS

Dresses, skirts, slacks, jogging outfits (nylon or silk), leggings with tunic top, shorts, and dress jeans or dress jean shorts void of any holes (Clubhouse Only).

WOMEN and GIRL'S UNACCEPTABLE DRESS

Fishnet tops, graphic t-shirts, cut-off shorts, jeans with holes, and bathing suits are not permitted.

DINING AREAS

* * * Changes in scheduled hours of operation will be posted on the website, in the newsletter, and sent through weekly emails.

BOGEY BISTRO

The Bogey Bistro is located on the lower level of the Clubhouse. This is a great place to grab a bite of breakfast, lunch, and dinner. This is a family casual table service dining option. The Bistro is available Tuesday – Sunday for breakfast and lunch as well as weekends for dinner.

If coming from the pool, please wear a cover-up before entering the bistro or sitting on the patio.

BOGEY ROOM

The Bogey Room is located on the upper level, off the Lounge. This room features tables with tablecloths and plated silverware. No hats are to be worn in this dining room. Lunch and dinner will be served here Tuesday – Sunday.

DECK

The Deck is located on the upper level, off the Lounge and is a family friendly place to dine. The hours of operation will be the same as the Lounge. Seating for the deck will be on a first come first serve basis on Saturday and Sunday. Reservations will be taken Tuesday through Friday.

LOUNGE (Casual dining)

The Lounge is located on the upper level of the Clubhouse. This room is available for family friendly dining during the week. On nights of entertainment, children are not allowed to dine in the Lounge.

MEMBER AMENITITES

FITNESS CENTER

The Fitness Center is located on the lower level of the Clubhouse. The Fitness Center is open from approximately 30 minutes before 1st tee time to 8:00pm Tuesday through Sunday. Please wear athletic attire that is considered appropriate for a family fitness center.

No mid-drift tops are to be worn. Tennis and/or athletic shoes must be worn while using the fitness center. Swimming attire is prohibited in the fitness center.

Children 12 and under must always be accompanied by an adult. Children ages 13–16 must complete an equipment training class. Guests are not allowed to use the fitness center.

Cell phones can be used with earbuds, but please be considerate of talking while others are around you. Please make sure to clean the machines, mats, and equipment after use. Do not use the wipes on the screens of the cardio equipment.

KIDS CLUB

Kids Club is located on the lower level near the Bistro. This room is available for use anytime the Club is open. Children 12 and under must always be accompanied by an adult. The Club will staff the room on Friday and Saturday 5:00pm - 11:00pm as well as additional times throughout the year. Children must be able to walk to utilize the room on nights with Bogey Hills staff. Bogey Hills staff will not be responsible for changing diapers. A nominal fee will be added to the member account on days when the room is staffed.

When the Kids Club is not staffed, the door will be closed. To use the Kids Club room an adult must check in at Bistro Bar. A Bogey Hills employee will inspect the room and perform a check-in process. There will be no food or drink allowed in the Kids Club room. Before leaving, an adult must check out at to the Bistro Bar and have a Bogey Hills employee inspect the room to make sure everything is in the same condition as it was found. Any damaged items will be charged to your member account.

LADIES LOCKER ROOM

Located on the lower level with a lounge area. Children 15 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

MENS LOCKER ROOM

Located on the lower level with a lounge area. Children 15 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

SIMULATOR ROOM

Located on the lower level near the fitness center and locker rooms. Simulator use is available to all Golfing and Sports members and their immediate family, as set forth in the Bylaws. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult to use the simulators. Tennis and/or athletic shoes must be worn while using the fitness center. The Simulator Room will follow the Bogey Bistro hours of operation. Tuesday through Sunday open (approximately 30 minutes before 1st tee time) to decline of business.

SWIMMING POOL

The swimming pool is open from Memorial Day through Labor Day. The pool is usually open Tuesday through Thursday 11am – 7pm and until 8pm on the weekends. If the kitchen is open that day, it will close 60 minutes before the pool closes.

EVENT SPACES

These spaces will be used for member events but are available for rental by contacting Amber Schuler.

BALLROOM

Located on the upper level of the Clubhouse. The dress in this room will be determined by the event.

COUNTRY CLUB ROOM

Located on the upper level of the Clubhouse, off the Grand Ballroom. The dress in this room will be determined by the event.

FAIRWAY ROOM

Located on the upper level of the Clubhouse, off the Grand Ballroom. The dress in this room will be determined by the event. This room has windows and is close to #10 tee box.

PAVILION

Located on the lower level outside of the Clubhouse. The dress for this location will be determined by the event, however; if coming down from the pool, a cover-up and shoes must be worn.

TEE ROOM

Located on the upper level of the Clubhouse, off the Lounge. The maximum number of people for this room is 16 people. This room overlooks the 1st tee box with a private door to the Deck. Please contact Wendy Johnson to book private parties.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES POLICY

It is the policy of Bogey Hills Country Club that it will not serve or participate in the serving of alcoholic beverages to any person who is not legally entitled to be served alcoholic beverages for any lawful reason including age, inebriation, or intoxication. In order to discourage excessive consumption, alcoholic beverages shall be served only by the drink on the premises and there shall be no sale of hard liquor by the bottle (bottled beer and wine are exceptions).

The Bogey Hills Country Club staff is authorized to terminate service of alcoholic beverages to any person who, in the judgment of an appropriate staff member, has or appears to have consumed an excessive amount of alcohol. No Member or guest shall reprimand or abuse any employee who exercises this judgment and, in the event a member disagrees with any such decision, they shall advise the General Manager within twenty-four hours thereafter. The General Manager will review the relevant facts and discuss the results of that review with the member who requested the review. Any member or guest who is or appears to be intoxicated at the Club shall be requested to surrender his/her keys and shall be transported home in a taxi called by him/her or by Club Management, at his/her own expense.

The General Manager will instruct the staff as to their authority to refuse service of alcoholic beverages to any person who has or appears to have consumed an excessive amount of alcohol.

HARASSMENT OF CLUB EMPLOYEES

The Club does not tolerate harassment of our employees. Members are reminded that both Members and any guests you bring to the Club must refrain from any form of harassment directed to Club employees, whether based on the employee's race, color, sex, marital status, pregnancy, sexual orientation, gender identity, religion, national origin, ethnicity, age, citizenship status, disability, handicap, or any other legally protected characteristic. Harassment includes, but is not limited to, slurs, jokes, and other verbal, graphic or physical conduct relating to an individual's race, color, sex, marital status, pregnancy, sexual orientation, gender identity, religion, national origin, ethnicity, age, citizenship status, disability, handicap, or any other characteristic protected by applicable law.

Sexual harassment includes any harassment based upon someone's sex or gender. It includes offensive or derogatory remarks about an individual's sex or gender, as well as unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal, graphic or physical conduct of a sexual nature.

Harassment based on any legally protected characteristic is prohibited and examples of prohibited conduct in include, but are not limited to:

- Verbal harassment (making comments that include sexual innuendo, talking about sexual topics at work, telling sexual jokes or stories, using racially derogatory epithets, making derogatory comments about a, race, religion, national origin, those with disabilities, etc.)
- Physical harassment (touching a person's hair, body, or clothing, massaging a person's neck, hugging or kissing someone)
- Visual (displaying sexually suggestive or derogatory visuals, or through text messages or any other form of communication).

Appropriate action will be taken by the Club should an employee report harassment by any Club Member or guest. In addition, retaliating against a Club employee for making a good faith complaint about harassment or for participating in an investigation into a harassment complaint is also strictly prohibited.

MISCELLANEOUS

- 1. Members will be expected to conduct themselves in a proper and courteous manner.
- 2. Members are not allowed in the kitchens, behind the lounge bar, behind the Bogey Bistro counters, behind the golf shop counter or inside the pool kitchen or bar.
- 3. All requests for special use of the Club should be directed to Amber Schuler, Corporate Events and Social Director Manager or Corporate Sales Manager
- 4. The Club assumes no responsibility for lost or stolen articles.
- 5. Reservations are strongly recommended for lunch, dinner, and member events throughout the Clubhouse.
 - a. Event reservations can be made these different ways:
 - i. In the calendar section of the Bogey Hills app or the website
 - ii. By calling the recorded reservation line $636-946-6250 \times 102$
 - b. Dining reservations can be made these different ways:
 - i. In the Bogey Hills app under the reservations tab
 - ii. By calling the recorded reservation line 636-946-6250 x1
- 6. All food and beverage must be purchased through the clubhouse or concession operation; no food or beverage can be brought into the clubhouse, the pool, or the golf course. Except for bottles of wine that will be charged a corkage fee.
- 7. It is unacceptable for any member or guest to abuse any of the employees, verbally or otherwise, nor shall any member request an employee to leave the Club facility for any purpose whatsoever. Any employee not rendering courteous and prompt service should be reported to the General Manager immediately.
- 8. Card playing should only be played in the locker rooms or designated areas.
- 9. Cell phones should be switched to vibrate in the Clubhouse and on the golf course. If you must take a phone call, please be aware of tables around you and go to the lobbies to speak on the phone. The bars and some seating are located next to outlets that have USB ports for plugging in your device.
- 10. Firearms are not permitted on Bogey Hills Country Club property.

SERVICE CHARGE

Every member of the Club is required to pay a service charge. Depending on your membership status this may be on your monthly bill or a percentage will be added to your ticket when dining.

The service charge is to help offset the hourly wage for the dining service staff. Bogey Hills pays above the hourly server wage set by the state of Missouri. Bogey Hills is a private facility and therefore does not operate like a public restaurant. The server does not directly get the service charge; however, they do indirectly receive it through their hourly wage. Tipping is at the member's discretion and that does go directly to the server.

This service charge does not affect the golf shop cart staff.

SIMULATOR ROOM

Simulator use is available to all Golfing and Sports members and their immediate family, as set forth in the Bylaws. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult to use the simulators.

Members may sign up with a tee time through the golf shop 636-946-6250 x2. Each simulator can accommodate up to 8 players at one time. Walk-ins are welcome but may have a wait if reservations are already made. All members must check in with the golf shop before starting play.

No outside food and drinks will be allowed. All food and beverage must remain in the simulator lounge area and out of the playing area.

SMOKING POLICY

Bogey Hills Country Club is a non-smoking building. You are available to smoke outside on the patio outside the Bogey Bistro at any time. The upper deck outside the lounge will be nonsmoking April 1st through October 31st.

Smoking including the use of electronic cigarettes of any kind is not permitted in the Clubhouse or other Club Buildings. Smoking of cannabis, marijuana or hemp products is not permitted on Club Property.

SWIMMING POOL

Entrance into the pool area is not permitted before 11am and the reservation of spots is not allowed.

Every member must sign in at the gate with all the names of people in attendance. Children 18 years and under must be accompanied by an adult. Children 13 years and older must be able to swim or touch the bottom of the pool in the 4' area (lanes). A caregiver for anyone under the age of 12 must be 18 years or older. A nanny or baby-sitter that oversees your children must be registered in the office as a caregiver/nanny and will be given a temporary card. Children 18 years and under are the only ones allowed to use the diving board.

Member account will be charged for any guest. Guest Fee is \$10 per guest per day. A maximum of four (4) guests per membership is permitted on holidays and weekends.

Swimmers must wear a bathing suit; no shorts or T-shirts will be allowed. Babies must wear swim diapers in the pool if not potty trained.

Bogey Hills does not provide towel service at the pool. Please bring your own.

Contact the pool manager for information on swimming lessons.

No outside food and beverages will be allowed in the pool or Clubhouse.

TRADITIONS COMMITTEE

The traditions committee upholds the family traditions of the club. The committee is available if any member would like to discuss decisions/policies or any issue a member does not agree with or would like further explanation. The committee will also discuss uncomfortable and/or unacceptable situations that are brought to the committee's attention that violate the member bylaws, rules, and regulations. This committee is responsible for enforcing the Bylaws for warnings, suspensions, and terminations. You can contact the General Manager if you would like to meet or discuss with the committee.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

All membership categories run on the Club fiscal year March 1st through February 28th. Please refer to the Club Bylaws for detailed information on memberships timeframes. Membership dues and fees are subject to change. Sales tax will be added to all dues and fees. You can obtain a current price sheet from the Membership Office.

SILVER GOLF MEMBERSHIP

This Membership allows full access to all club amenities for the entire family. Spouse and children under the age of 24 still living at home are considered part of this membership. Play on Club golf course, subject to the priority of booked starting times on Bogey Hills Golf and Country Club. Golf privileges include the waiver of green fees. Clubhouse privileges to include the dining rooms, swimming pool, fitness center, and golf simulators.

EXECUTIVE GOLF MEMBERSHIP

This Membership allows full access to the first golf course for the member only. Play on Club golf course, subject to the priority of booked starting times on Bogey Hills Golf and Country Club. Golf privileges include the waiver of green fees. Member, spouse, and children under the age of 24 still living at home are considered part of this membership for the clubhouse privileges to include the three dining rooms, swimming pool, fitness center, and golf simulators. Spouse and children are required to abide by the guest rules for playing golf.

BRONZE GOLF MEMBERSHIP

This Membership is for those individuals that are under the age of 40 years. The age is calculated based on the age of the youngest spouse. This membership type allows full access to all club amenities for the entire family. Spouse and children under the age of 24 still living at home are considered part of this membership. Play on Club golf course, subject to the priority of booked starting times on Bogey Hills Golf and Country Club. Golf privileges include the waiver of green fees. Clubhouse privileges to include the dining rooms, swimming pool, fitness center, and golf simulators.

SPORTS MEMBERSHIP

This Membership allows play on the golf course for a limit of four (4) rounds in a fiscal year. Play on Club golf course is subject to the priority of booked starting times on Bogey Hills Golf and Country Club. Golf privileges include the waiver of green fees for the four (4) rounds. Sports members must abide by the guest rules after the four (4) rounds have been used. Use of the putting and chipping area, and the range are subject to availability and with an additional fee. Member, spouse, and children under the age of 24 still living at home are considered part of this membership for the clubhouse privileges to include the dining rooms, swimming pool, fitness center, and golf simulators.

SOCIAL MEMBERSHIP

This Membership allows for access to the clubhouse privileges to include the dining rooms, swimming pool, and social activities of the Club. Spouse and children under the age of 24 still living at home are considered part of this membership.

DINING MEMBERSHIP

This Membership allows for access to the dining rooms of the Club. Spouse and children under the age of 24 still living at home are considered part of this membership. Participation in social events is not a privilege for this membership.

SENIOR MEMBERSHIP

This Membership is for those individuals that have been a member for at least 20 consecutive years and are at least 75 years of age. The dues are discounted on the Full Golf Membership rate. Play on Club golf course, subject to the priority of booked starting times on Bogey Hills Golf and Country Club. Golf privileges include the waiver of green fees. Clubhouse privileges include the three dining rooms, swimming pool, fitness center, and golf simulator.

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

This Membership is for those individuals that have a corporation pay their Initiation Fee and the annual membership dues. Corporate members shall have and receive the same rights and services of the respective class of membership for their dues category. Corporations are available to transfer the designated user once per calendar year. If four (4) members are joining a reduction of the Initiation Fee will be granted. New applicants must go through the new membership process as stated in Article III Section 2 of the Club Bylaws.

GOLF COURSE DRESS CODE

GOLF DRESS CODE

Acceptable dress is required. It is the member's responsibility to notify their guests as to proper dress as defined below. The definition below is not to be considered all-inclusive and the determination of improper dress is at the discretion of the golf professional staff.

ACCEPTABLE DRESS FOR MEN AND BOYS

Tucked in shirts with sleeves and collars, slacks, golf or walking shorts. Caps and hats must be forward facing.

UNACCEPTABLE DRESS FOR MEN AND BOYS

Tank Tops, cut offs, sweatpants, tennis shorts or athletic shorts, jeans and denim of any kind, untucked shirts. No caps or visors to be worn backwards.

ACCEPTABLE DRESS FOR WOMEN AND GIRLS

Dresses, skirts, slacks and joggers, golf shorts, shirts must have a collar or sleeves, but can't be void of both. Caps and hats must be forward facing.

UNACCEPTABLE DRESS FOR WOMEN AND GIRLS

Halter tops, sweatpants, leggings, tennis or athletic shorts, jeans and denim of any kind. No caps or visors to be worn backwards.

SHOES

Appropriate spikeless or alternative spiked golf shoes are required on the golf course and practice area. Use of shoes other than golf shoes must be approved by the golf shop. Football spikes and baseball spikes are not permitted.

GOLF COURSE RULES & REGULATIONS

GOLF CARTS & PULL CARTS

- 1. Only golf carts owned by Bogey Hills Golf & Country Club or those approved by the General Manager will be allowed.
- 2. Only licensed drivers will be allowed to drive golf carts.
- 3. Always drive on paths when possible. The Visage GPS System will not allow carts to be driven within 30 yards of the greens or when carts are not allowed off the cart paths. Carts are required to remain on cart paths on all Par 3 holes and #18 fairway.
- 4. Golf carts are restricted to Club property.
- 5. No more than two bags and two riders per cart.
- 6. The Club will not be liable for accidents caused by members and/or guests.
- 7. Members and guests are responsible for any and all damage to their assigned cart. Damage must be reported to the golf shop immediately upon completion of play.
- 8. The cost of renting golf carts is <u>not included</u> in monthly dues for members and is not included in the greens fee for guests. There is an optional annual cart fee available.
- 9. Please report malfunctions and needed repairs for any carts.
- 10. Failure to operate carts safely in accordance with the above regulations, additional posted rules and all club signage may result in the suspension of cart privileges.
- 11. Pull carts should remain off the collar of the greens and tee boxes.
- 12. Private pull carts cannot be left on club grounds overnight without a rented storage space.
- 13. Bogey Hills Country Club assumes no responsibility for private pull carts.

CART PATH RULES

Cart path rules will be dictated by the Head Superintendent on a daily basis. During the "offseason" All Carts will be restricted to the Cart Path Only, with the exception of Handicap Flags (see below). During the peak season Carts may be allowed on both the fairways and roughs or just fairways only based on Superintendent preference. Please refer to the Cart Rules sign located on the first tee for daily information or inquire in the Golf Shop. The Visage GPS system will automatically shut down your cart if you drive in any restricted areas.

GOLF COURSE

- the Head Golf Professional or Greens Superintendent may close all or any part of the course due to weather conditions or tournament play, for required maintenance, or any other condition which may adversely impact all or part of the golf course.
- 2. All golfers must check in with the golf shop prior to play or range use.
- 3. All players must replace divots, repair ball marks, and rake bunkers.
- 4. Practice must be confined to designated driving range, short game area, and practice putting green. Range balls are for use on the practice area only. Use of range balls on the golf course is prohibited.
- 5. The golf course may not be used for any purpose except golf without the advanced written approval of the Head Golf Professional. This is to include the prohibition of jogging, riding bikes, skateboards, skates, motorized vehicles, walking (other than playing golf), skiing, sledding, ice skating, fishing, or any other activity other than golf. Violators should be reported to management immediately.
- 6. Each player must have their own golf bag and clubs.
- 7. Only beverages and food purchased from the clubhouse will be allowed on Bogey Hills Country Club grounds. No personal coolers will be allowed.
- 8. For the enjoyment of all players and to encourage proper spacing on the course, the club will attempt to create foursomes for each time slot whenever possible.
- 9. Each golfer is responsible, to the full extent required by law, for any and all damages caused by themselves or their guests including damage to the club, surrounding property, or any persons on club property.
- 10. Hunting for golf balls (ball hawking) in creeks, lakes, or anywhere on the golf course property, either during a round of golf, or on days the golf course is closed, is strictly prohibited.
- 11. Please report all incidents to the golf shop immediately.

GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

Bogey Hills Country Club is known for its outstanding course layout, playability, and conditioning. It is very important for members and guests, as well as the club staff, to play an important role in our ability to be able to provide and maintain a quality golf course. We ask that all members, guests, and staff take the time to repair ball marks on the greens, rake bunkers, and abide by daily/seasonal cart rules. All members assume responsibility for themselves and their guests regarding damaged property of Bogey Hills Country Club that occurs outside the normal course of play.

GOLF PLAY POLICY

All members must check in prior to their tee time and provide the club with all the information needed for the time. The Club reserves the right to pair singles, 2-somes, and 3-somes as needed.

5-somes are allowed any time throughout the week with the approval of The Head Golf Professional. The Club reserves the right to break up any 5-some or group that does not meet adequate pace of play standards or does not exercise proper etiquette regarding faster groups.

A cancellation is required at least 24 hours in advance of the scheduled tee time. If a member and/or their guests fail to appear for a reserved time, the member will be liable for all the fees associated with the tee time. This policy is designed to discourage "no-shows" that otherwise deprive other members and their guests access to the course.

All days devoid of member events/tournaments will have tee times allotted for various skin games throughout the day. These are long-standing games that are a big part of Bogey Hills Country Club. The golf shop staff will help accommodate tee time requests around these games or will gladly expedite the inclusion of any member and their guests into whichever "Skin Game" they choose to play with.

GOLF PRIVILEGES FOR GUEST

- 1. Guest Greens fees shall be determined by Management.
- 2. Bogey Members are responsible for making tee times for their guest, as well as for the conduct of their guest. All guests must be accompanied by a member.
- 3. A guest will be allowed to play six (6) times during the calendar year. Any guest that is a member of an area district club may exceed 6 rounds per year but will be subject to a premium guest fee.
- 4. Guests will be permitted on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays with permission from the golf shop.
- 5. The Head Golf Professional may extend reciprocal privileges to members of other district clubs Tuesday through Friday and after 12:00pm on Saturday, Sunday, and holidays.

HANDICAP FLAGS

You may obtain a handicap flag from the golf shop if you have submitted a letter from a Doctor to the Membership Office. Doctor's notes must state the specific reason for the need and the length of time you will be affected by the disability. Doctor's notes also must be submitted annually. Flags may be warranted for a variety of reasons, such as: knee replacements, joint replacements, heart issues and many other physical ailments. Handicap Flags are offered by Bogey Hills Country Club to aid in the enjoyment of golf for members who otherwise struggle to play or finish the round. Handicap Flags are available for members ONLY and can be prohibited by the Golf Course Superintendent at certain times. Handicap flags for golf carts will be issued as a privilege, not as a convenience.

Procedures for use of Handicap Flags:

- 1. Handicap flags are not a license to drive anywhere you please. Carts with flags are required to remain on the path on all Par 3 holes and #18 fairway.
- 2. Golf carts are never to be driven closer than 30 yards from the greens and tees.
- 3. Golf Carts are to be taken at a 90-degree angle to and from your ball.
- 4. Driving the length of the rough is not permitted.
- 5. A flag is issued to the individual it is meant for, therefore taking someone to their ball who is not issued a flag is a violation of the flag rule.
- 6. If there are multiple flags issued in a group, those individuals must ride in the same cart.

If the rules are violated, you will receive a warning. If the rules are violated a second time, then flag suspension will be taken away for up to two weeks. After a third violation flag privileges will be revoked.

HOLE IN ONE CLUB

Bogey Hills offers a Hole In One Club for Members ONLY. In order to sign up for the Hole In One Club, please contact the golf shop. There is no entry fee into the Hole-In-One Club. Any time a hole-in-one is made by a member in this club either at Bogey Hills or any other course in a regulation round, each member will be charged \$15. The player will receive these funds in the form of merchandise credit in the golf shop (2/3 of the pot) and bar credit (1/3 of the pot). The Hole-In-One comes with the following requirements:

- 1. There must be a witness or witnesses.
- 2. Must be made in a regulation 9- or 18-hole round (no mulligan's) or any Bogey Hills Member golf event.

If you would like to sign up or be removed from the Hole in One Club, please contact the golf shop

JUNIOR GOLFER RULES

- 1. Children up to the age of eleven (11) are permitted on the course, practice green, and practice range only when accompanied by an adult member or an approved family member by the golf shop. Children up to the age of eleven (11) may play golf, when accompanied by an adult, after 1:00pm or when deemed appropriate by the golf staff, normal weekdays, weekends, and holidays.
- 2. Children 12 through 18 years of age may play the course normal weekdays before 11:00am and after 1:00pm, and normal weekends and holidays after 12:00pm (or when deemed appropriate by the golf shop staff).
- 3. Tee times for children 19 and older will be at the discretion of the Head Golf Professional.
- 4. Children of any age will not be permitted to play in adult club events.
- 5. All children under age 16 are encouraged to join the Junior Golf Program to learn the rules and etiquette of golf.
- 6. Only licensed drivers will be allowed to drive golf carts.

LOCKER ROOM ATTENDANT SERVICES

The Locker Room Attendant will be on duty Tuesday through Saturday during the season. All leather products will be cleaned, conditioned, and shined. Services are as follows with prices subject to change:

MEMBER DISCOUNTS IN THE GOLF SHOP

As a member of Bogey Hills Country Club, you will receive a discount on all merchandise purchased from the golf shop. Discounts vary based on items, but as a general rule you will receive 20% off retail on soft goods and 10% off retail on hard goods.

MUSIC ON THE COURSE

Audio and Video

Permitted: Listening to audio or watching video on matters unrelated to the competition being played (such as a new report or background music.) But in doing so, consideration shown to others.

Not Permitted: Listening to music or other audio to eliminate distractions or to help with swing tempo. Viewing video showing play of the player or other players during the competition that helps the player in choosing a club, make a stroke, or deciding how to play during the round.

PACE OF PLAY

The expected pace of play has been established at 4 hours. This pace of play should allow all members and guests to enjoy the golf course without feeling rushed or impeded. All players, regardless of members or guests, or walking or riding, are expected to complete their rounds in a maximum of 4 hours.

Our staff will assist both members and guests in achieving this goal. Listed below are a few guidelines and suggestions for maintaining pace:

- -All groups are expected to maintain their position on the golf course relative to the group directly in front of them. A group that tees off a half hole behind a group on #1 is expected to maintain that half hole gap throughout the round.
- -If a member or guest group falls out of position, either relative to the group in front of them or to the 4-hour pace, a staff member will speak to that group and ask for their cooperation in getting back into position. If a group is unable to do so, the staff member may ask the group to skip a shot or a hole to get back into position.

These expectations for pace of play are not just that of the Club's management, but also for our Membership. The club will do our best to communicate the pace of play expectations to unaccompanied guests in advance of their rounds, but we also ask for each member's help in communicating these expectations to their guests as well. Pace of play will also be monitored by a GPS system in the Golf Shop.

Pace of Play Helpful Tips:

- 1. Play ready golf throughout the entire round.
- 2. Walk fast.
- 3. The first person to complete each hole should immediately go to the next tee and is expected to be the first person to tee off. The second person to finish should replace the flagstick.
- 4. Know where your group is in relation to the group in front of you.
- 5. Get your yardage and be ready to play before it is your turn to play.
- 6. If someone isn't quite ready to play, another player should play before them.
- 7. When any shot heads toward rough, a water hazard or trees, all players should watch closely as to where the ball lands.
- 8. Read your putt before it is your turn to play.
- 9. Recognize when someone will need the flagstick attended or your ball marked.
- 10. Place your golf bag or park your golf cart near the next teeing ground.
- 11. If your ball might be lost outside a water hazard or out of bounds, play a Provisional Ball.

POSTING SCORES

The following are acceptable scores and MUST be posted for handicap posting purposes:

- 1. Post scores from home or away golf courses.
- 2. Post scores when at least 9 holes are played.
- 3. Post scores made in an area observing an active golf season.
- 4. Post scores made under "The Rules of Golf."
- 5. Post scores on all courses with a valid USGA Course Rating and Slope Rating.
- 6. Post scores in all forms of competition: stroke play and team competitions where players play their own ball.
- 7. Post scores played under the Local Rule of "preferred lies."

The following are unacceptable scores and CANNOT be posted for handicap posting purposes:

- 1. Do not post scores when the score cannot be verified by another person.
- 2. Do not post scores when fewer than 9 holes are played.
- 3. Do not post scores made on a golf course in an area in which an inactive season established by the authorized golf association is in effect.
- 4. Do not post scores made when a majority of the holes are not played in accordance with the principles of "The Rules of Golf."
- 5. Do not post scores when, as a condition of the competition, the maximum number of clubs allowed is less than 14, or types of clubs are limited as for example, in a competition that only allows irons.
- 6. Do not post scores when scores are made on a course with no USGA Course Rating and Slope Rating.
- 7. Do not post scores when a player carries or uses non-conforming clubs or uses non-conforming balls or tees
- 8. Do not post scores when artificial devices (as defined under rule 14-3) are used during the execution of a stroke.

The Golf Shop may enter tournament scores. Please check with a staff member. The Golf Shop will be checking weekly and weekend score postings. Please note it is the member's responsibility to post his or her score each time they play.

PRACTICE FACILITY USE

All the above rules and regulations, in terms of dress code and etiquette, do apply to the practice facility as well. Guests can use the practice facility only as invited guests of members. No additional practice privileges are extended to guests. All practice facility users must check in at the golf shop prior to using the facility. Golfing members are entitled to unlimited practice range use upon availability and operation hours. Sports members may use the range for a daily fee of \$15.00.

Practice facilities may be closed at the discretion of the Greens Superintendent or the Golf Shop Staff for various reasons ranging from but not specific to; unplayable conditions, construction, safety issues, member tournaments, clinics, Junior Golf, and maintenance. When practice facilities are closed, no golfers are permitted anywhere on the practice facility unless accompanied by a member of the Golf Professional Staff.

Off-Season use will be dependent on weather conditions.

PRIVATE CARTS

All private carts must carry liability insurance. A copy of the policy and renewals must be provided to the club office annually and will remain in your member file. Colors and type of cart must be approved by the General Manager.

Members with private carts must have direct access to a cart path. Driving in the rough to the cart path is not considered direct access.

PROFESSIONAL CLUB REPAIR SERVICE CHARGES

The Club Management will set charges for Professional Club Repair Services.

ROUND LIMITS

Full Golf Members - Unlimited Play.

Executive Members – Unlimited Play for main member. Other family is considered guest.

Bridge Members – Limit of 30 rounds per year for main member. Other family is considered guest.

Sports Members – Limit of 4 rounds per year. Then must abide by the guest rules.

Guest of Members – 6 rounds per guest at regular guest fees. See below in Golf Privileges for Guest for more details.

TEE TIME RESERVATIONS

Tee time reservations can be placed via the website or Bogey Hills app. Times can also be placed through the golf shop with the golf professionals on staff.

TOURNAMENT POLICY

You must be a full golf member with a GHIN handicap to play in any Club Trophy Events.

LADIES GOLF ASSOCIATION

The Bogey Hills Ladies Golf Association is focused on providing social gatherings and golf events for the women of the Club. In simple terms, the BHLGA handles the fun and social events while the competitive tournaments are handled by the Golf Professional Staff. Female members of the Club must join the Bogey Hills Ladies Golf Association to participate in the weekly games. If you would like more information about the Bogey Hills Ladies Golf Association at Bogey Hills, please stop by the golf shop.

The 18-Hole Ladies play on Tuesday mornings. On holiday weekends where Monday is considered a holiday and open to the members, the Club will be closed the following Tuesday and there will be no Ladies League. Tuesday Ladies League will shotgun start at 8:30am. Sign-up sheets will be posted in the ladies' locker room and must be filled out the Sunday before play. Ladies may also sign up via Golf Genius.

^{*}Tuesday Ladies Golf Association play day will delay open play start time. Check with Golf Shop as times may vary on participation numbers.

JUNIOR GOLF (FUTURE GOLFERS ACADEMY)

Every season our goal is to create a fun atmosphere where kids will be engaged and motivated to improve their game. Our weekly curriculum will include instruction focused around the fundamentals of golf, and age/experience based pairings while playing on course.

The FGA will be divided into individual 5-week instructional and 4 on-course play day sessions. Along with our season ending session consisting of a Fun Day on the driving range and putting green. The sessions will begin on June 20th and continue until August 1st. We will meet each week on Tuesday and Sunday Evenings.

The FGA play days are formatted to help young players see success by applying the skills they have learned from the instructional clinics to their on-course round. Placing players by age/ability level will allow them to make friends and play with others that have similar abilities and make for a more enjoyable golf experience. During the course setup each week, the yardage and weekly game will allow them to apply their skills developed from the lesson to on course play.

Group Age / Skill / Yardage

3 Hole Group (New / Beginner) – 350-400 Yards 6 Hole Group (Beginner / Intermediate) – 1200-1300 Yards

To help our future golfers focus on the core aspects of our academy they will receive rewards in the form of Achievement Chips. Rewardable achievements will range from demonstrations of sportsmanship, logging outside practice time, course maintenance and etiquette, and displaying skills learned from previous weeks lessons. Chips will be redeemable at the end of the session. We will have a "store" full of goodies for them to trade their chips for.

Parental Involvement

Parental involvement in Junior Golf is strongly encouraged during play. Parental supervision in the groups helps with child safety, assistance with score keeping, potential pace of play issues, and etiquette.

PGA JR LEAGUE

PGA Jr. League is a game-changing opportunity for boys and girls to learn and play golf. The program brings family and friends together around fun, team golf experiences with expert coaching from the Golf Professionals here at Bogey Hills. PGA Jr. League is a great option for additional play and friendly competition for those junior players who are experienced and looking to expand their game. Registration starts in early February each season.

PGA Jr. League is comprised of local golf teams playing in friendly competitions that encourage both skill development and team building. PGA Jr. League is played in a fun and exciting scramble format, where two players per team compete at one time, the best shot from the two is selected and the shot is played until the ball is holed out. Teams wear numbered jerseys and play four nine-hole matches per game, with the ability to substitute players every three holes, ensuring that all team members have the chance to participate. Similar to other youth sports, this format allows new players to fully engage in the game by learning in a team environment first and working toward a higher level of performance later. This encouraging and fun atmosphere keeps kids engaged and interested in continuing to play golf as they grow older.

Here is a brief rundown of what to expect in 2025. During the season, new and exciting games and pools are always dreamt up and created, so this is only a partial list. MARCH MADNESS FILL-IN POOL

Be a part of March Madness! Pick your favorites and underdogs on the Road to the Final Four. You'll enjoy filling in your brackets and watching all the action for six rounds. Standings are updated weekly.

MLB 13-RUN POOL

Turning to baseball, we offer a typical 13-run pool. Each member in the pool will be drawn one of the 30 teams. They will have that team until the All-Star Break, at which point, we will re-draw for the balance of the regular season. If your team scores 13 runs in a given game, you are a winner. If 13 runs are not scored in a given week, the pool carries over to the next week. Many members have won large carry-over amounts in the past and there is no reason this year will be any different. This pool builds significant golf shop credit.

THE MASTERS, U.S. OPEN, BRITISH OPEN, PGA CHAMPIONSHIP, GRAND SLAM

These golf pools are the ones that everybody is talking about. You get to pick a 7-man team from a group of 7 boxed players. Wild card picks are also available and are encouraged. Winners of these tournaments typically pick one player that plays well and nobody else has him on their team. In pool lingo, this is called a solo. Winners are determined by the best 4 cumulative scores of your 7-man team. Watching a major golf tournament and rooting for your favorite players with major golf shop credit on the line is both fun and exciting. The Grand Slam Pool is a pool within a pool. There is no additional entry fee as 10% of each major's entry fees are withheld for the winners of the Grand Slam Pool. After the last major we total your scores from the four tournaments and declare a winner.

N.F.L. 33-POINT POOL

Similar to the baseball pool, we have football fun with the 33-point pool. We draw a team for each of the 32 players and they have that team for the first 9 weeks of the season. After 9 weeks, we redraw and your new team takes you through the Super Bowl, if you're lucky. The hard part is having your team score exactly 33 points. The carryover aspect of this pool is tremendous. 4-digit winnings in golf shop credit are not unheard of (see Bob Davis, Rusty Shelley, and Gary Melchior).

SUPER BOWL SQUARES POOL

The club also has everybody's favorite, the 100-square grid representing all possible scores in the Super Bowl. We will have two separate pools and sell squares for both \$25 and \$50 for a potential \$5000 pot in shop credit. A winner will be determined at the end of the 1st quarter, 2nd quarter, 3rd quarter, and final game score. Winners are determined by looking at the last number in each teams' score, and then matching those numbers on the grid to see which square intersects those two numbers.

These pools are the highlights of our season. Throughout the course of the year, new games will be created to keep things fresh. We are always thinking of exciting contests to keep Bogey Hills fun.
